Note from the editor: According to information that was printed in Mr. Carl H. Knaus' obituary, "Burlington Cemetery was the first cemetery used by early settlers of this area. The earliest marked burial was in 1864, although it is believed that there are earlier burials. In 1887 those families with burials at the cemetery purchased the seven acres for \$17.50 and formed the Burlington Cemetery Association. This association has been carried on and supported by the descendants of that original group."

The plat map of Burlington Cemetery that is on file with Boulder County Clerk and Recorder has a note that states "The original cemetery land extended west of South Sunset Street and was divided into Blocks 2, 3, 4, 5, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18. No burials were ever made in these blocks, and the present cemetery includes only Blocks 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 which are subdivided into the lots shown."
